Corporate Giving Guidelines

JGI does not accept contributions from companies whose activities conflict with or undermine JGI's core values, mission statement and broad objectives. In this connection each Chapter shall, subject to discretionary oversight by JGIG, exercise its own judgment and discretion in respect of the appropriateness of accepting contribution from certain sources.

Companies or organisations who are involved in the manufacture, sale or distribution of equipment or materials used by or in furtherance of the defence industry or the arms industry

Contributions from such companies or organisations should be considered with great care by any Chapter considering support or funding from such sources. Whilst there is no absolute prohibition on receiving such contribution the Chapter would wish to consider the extent of the company or organisations involvement in such a trade, what proportion of its business it involves and whether it involves the provision of lethal or none lethal equipment or materials. It would be considered best practice when considering such a contribution for the Chapter to refer the matter to the Ethics Committee of JGIG to ensure that a consistent approach is adopted globally and that there are not adverse consequences for other areas of JGI's work and mission that could be affected by such an arrangement.
